# The Chinese University of Hong Kong Center for Entrepreneurship Annual Report for July 2007 to June 2008

The following reviews the accomplishments, governance and financing of The Chinese University of Hong Kong Center for Entrepreneurship (CfE) for the year 2007-8.

### I. Accomplishments

The year was eventful and successful and is summarized under the headings *teaching*, *practice* and *research* below. Please refer to Attachment 1 for a full list of activities and Attachment 2 news clippings in the local press concerning the CfE.

## 1. **Teaching**

The CfE encouraged the introduction of teaching entrepreneurship both at the post-graduate and undergraduate levels. The MBA full time program introduced in September 2008 a concentration in Entrepreneurship, its fourth concentration (after Finance, Marketing and China Business). Our executive board members taught entrepreneurship modules in the General Education courses of United College, New Asia College and Chung Chi College.

We organized the Family and Closely Held Business Forum in cooperation with the CUHK Center for Corporate Governance in July 2008, co-sponsored (with the Hong Kong Venture Capital and Private Equity Association) the Cyberport Venture Capital Forum in December 2007 and assisted at the Red Herring Conference in the Grand Hyatt in August 2007, where our students had the opportunity to interact with entrepreneurs and professionals who support them.

The CfE co-organized a program with the Hong Kong Design Center involving a series of seven modules and one site visit on entrepreneurship for designers and creative business from March to June 2008. The second intake courses will take place from November to December 2008.

From January through April, the CfE hosted an interdisciplinary team of CUHK students to use a methodology and software system called Kubus, developed by Prof. Henrik Herlau of the Oresund Entrepreneurship Academy in Denmark to do research for a company in Hong Kong. The CUHK students were trained in Kubus methodology in order to help the targeted company find out "what they don't know that they should have known".

In July the CfE and Stanford Technology Ventures Program, an entrepreneurship center in the engineering faculty of Stanford University, agreed to co-host in Hong Kong from 21<sup>st</sup> through 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2009 the Roundtable on Entrepreneurship Education. This global conference will be jointly run at CUHK by the CfE and the Center for Innovation and Technology of the Faculty of Engineering (CINTEC).

#### 2. Practice

The CfE ran two annual CUHK-wide business plan competitions, the Vice Chancellor's Cup of Students Entrepreneurship (VCCE) and the Booz and Company Social Venture Challenge (B&CSVC) on November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2007 and May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2008 respectively. The competitions involved a series of mixers, seminars and feedback sessions. Many teams in B&CSVC and VCCE included students from diverse departments. Faculties represented included Business Administration, Social

Sciences, Sciences, Engineering and Medicine and some teams included both undergraduate and postgraduate students. When students work in diverse teams, they learn from each other and increase their chances of rolling out real companies. Members of both the first place team (*V-Miner*) and third place team (*Design for Movies and Animations*) which included engineering, business and social science students, have enrolled in the incubator program at CINTEC. The winner of B&CSVC (*Golden Rice Mountain*) carried out a field test on this soil-less rice cultivation while members of the fourth placed team in B&CSVC (*One*) received funding from a private investor to implement the first phase of their social venture.

This year, CUHK sent more business plan teams to overseas competitions than in any other year. Two winning VCCE teams represented CUHK at international competitions and acquitted themselves well: our second place team, *RFIDEEE*, represented CUHK at the Asia Moot Corp competition in Bangkok in March 2008 and our first place team, *V-Miner*, was a semi-finalist in Global Moot Corp in Texas in May 2008, took first place in the Hong Kong-wide YDC e-Challenge and was the only Hong Kong and Macao winner of gold at the China Challenge Cup in 2008. *Design for Movies and Animations*, represented CUHK at San Diego State University in March 2008. Teams of MBA students from the full time program and the Finance MBA part-time CUHK-Tsingha program in Shenzhen represented CUHK at the University of San Francisco 2008 International Business Plan Competition and the New Venture Championship of the Lundquist Center for Entrepreneurship, University of Oregon competitions in April 2008.

In March 2008, the Home Affairs Bureau of the Hong Kong Government approved the application of the CfE to fund the second Hong Kong Social Entrepreneurship Challenge (HKSEC). HKSEC is a social venture business plan competition program open to all undergraduate and postgraduate students in Hong Kong, encouraging them to employ entrepreneurial approaches to solve real world social problems. The final for the competition will take place in January 2009, with the winners being given the opportunity to implement their business plans.

#### 3. Research

In January 2008 we released the findings of the Global Entrepreneurship Monitor Hong Kong 2007 study (completed from May 2007 to December 2007) in a news conference so-sponsored by the American Chamber of Commerce and in July we completed publication of the studies in English and Chinese.

We are working with the Successful Trans-generational Entrepreneurship Project under the leadership of Babson College and involving Bond University (Australia), Indian School of Business, Nankai University (China), National Sun Yat Sen University (Taiwan), National University of Singapore, Queensland University of Technology (Australia), Seoul National University (Korea), Sun Yat Sen University (China) and Waseda University (Japan) to conduct research into succession in family businesses. The research will be presented at the STEP conference to be hosted in November 2008 at CUHK. We anticipate that this effort will lead to the publication of a set of case research studies.

The CfE hosted a visiting scholar from the Beijing Academy of Social Sciences, Professor Gang Shuge to performed research at The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) during the period from the end of June to the end of July 2008.

The CfE, under the initiative of Kevin Au, is co-investigator with Nan Kai University (the

principal investigator) in a major research project *Models of New Enterprise Formation and Growth* funded by the National Social Sciences Fund of China (project #73732004).

# II. Governance and Management

The membership of the Executive Board for 2006-7 was as follows:

The Executive Board officially met twice during the year on August 28, 2007 and March 5, 2008.

The members of the Executive Board also met numerous times unofficially.

For the coming year 2008-2009, the members of the Executive Board is unchanged from 2007-2008

All members of the Advisory Board met in a formal meeting at CUHK on June 27<sup>th</sup> to consider the activities, strategy and funding of the CfE. In addition, its members met with members of the Executive Board individually on numerous occasions to fulfill their advisory roles and came to several of our functions to lend their expertise and support.

Our founding director, Professor Chua Bee-leng, who is currently Professor and Director of the Center for Entrepreneurship at Hawaii Pacific University, continues to actively advise the CfE.

In August 2007, Mr. Mingles Tsoi, a business development professional and active United College Alumnus, was appointed as Research Assistant (carrying the title "Project Officer") for an unpaid six month position to direct the efforts of the CfE concerning social enterprise in general and the Hong Kong Social Enterprise Challenge in particular. In April 2007, he was appointed for a 12 month period as paid position as Research Assistant carrying the title "Project Officer" for social ventures. His primary responsibility is management of HKSEC.

In March 2008, Mr. Bernard Suen was re-appointed for one year to the position of Research Assistant, carrying the title of "Project Officer" for new media. Bernard is the partner of Esthete Creative Consultants and with the title of Business Director. Bernard has regularly taught courses

on contract bases in new media in CUHK's School of Journalism and Communication. He has been active in the CfE particularly in offering the Hong Kong Design Institute Course.

In August Dr. Wilton Chau, Managing Director, QLeap Asia, a venture capital firm specializing in early stage investment, was appointed for one year to the position of "Project Director". Wilton has taught successfully the MBA course *Venture Capital and Private Equity* and is active in promoting the applied research agenda of the CfE.

The day-to-day activities of the Center continue to be run by Rosanna Lo Wing Shan, Research Assistant, whose contract was renewed (with end of contract merit award) for another one year in November 2008.

In April we hired Angela Ng Yuet Ngor, Project Coordinator on a one-year contract to implement the Hong Kong Social Enterprise Challenge. Angela also ran the CfE while Rosanna was away on maternity leave from July – October 2008.

Dennise Tsang Yuk Kwan, Project Coordinator II left the CfE upon the expiry of her one year contract in January 2008.

From August 2008 to December 2008 we hired Sammi Leung Nga Shan to assist with the Social Entrepreneurship Challenge.

## III. Financing

The CfE over the last year has been financed by a combination of external grants from the government, with the largest being \$647,000 to support the Hong Kong Social Enterprise Challenge 2008-9), the Faculty of Business Administration (\$120,000 for administration plus \$95,000 from the Asia Pacific Institute of Business to cover the printing costs of the GEM 2007 report), external sponsorship from business and private donations totaling \$126,000, and conference fees of \$87,300.

We would appreciate any and all suggestions that the reader has concerning how we can pursue our mission to understand, document and promote entrepreneurship through research, education and practice and, in the process, to establish CUHK as a global leader in entrepreneurship.
